When is Adventure Cruise?

Adventure Cruise takes place from 19 to 23 August 2013.

Where is Adventure Cruise?

If your child is currently in Reception or Year 1, 2 or 3, their branch of Adventure Cruise takes place at Christ Church, Epsom Road, Leatherhead, KT22 8ST. Doors open at 10am. The programme runs from 10:15am to 12:15pm.

If your child is currently in Year 4, 5 or 6, their programme is at BFree Youth Café, Kingston Road, Leatherhead, KT22 7BT. Doors open at 9:45am. The programme runs from 10am to 12 noon.

On Friday 23 August, we will have a final celebration at Christ Church, including a picnic for the whole family starting at 12:30pm. Further details will follow, when we acknowledge your booking.

Who's in charge?

Adventure Cruise is organised by Leatherhead Uniting Churches – a partnership of Leatherhead's Methodist, Church of England and United Reformed Churches. We work in partnership with Leatherhead Youth Project and Jay Bristow, one of LYP's youth workers, will organise the programme at BFree for Years 4, 5 and 6.

What kind of activities do you do?

The activities will include crafts, games, songs, stories and competitions. All our activities are based around a Christian teaching programme. This year's programme uses the theme of an ocean journey to explore the theme of a "journey of discovery" – expect seagulls, sharks, pirates and plenty of "aye, aye me hearties!" The Bible stories are all about people who met Jesus and how their lives were changed for the better.

I am not religious, does it matter?

No. Our holiday clubs are designed to be enjoyed by all children, whether they normally go to church or not. The emphasis is on fun and friendship. We will not make any assumptions about what children believe, nor will we pressurise anyone into expressing beliefs that are alien to them. But the Christian content is an important part of the programme. We will encourage the children to think about the Bible stories, in a way that is sensitive to their age, experience and family background.

Where should I send my form?

How much is Adventure Cruise?

£10 per week for one child, or £18 for a family of two or more siblings. Cheques should be made payable to "Leatherhead Methodist Church". Please send your cheque with your booking form.

We have tried to keep Adventure Cruise as cheap as possible, while still providing an exciting programme! But we will not turn anyone away from our Holiday Club. If money is really tight, please pay whatever you can manage.

Can my pre-school child come with their older siblings?

Sorry, no. The programme is designed for school-aged children and our experience is that pre-schoolers can find it a bit overwhelming.

My child can't come every day. Does that matter?

No, but please let us know which days they are not coming, so that we can use the place for someone else.
